

Primers used for *Bacillus licheniformis* MLST scheme

The Bacillus MLST scheme uses internal fragments of the following six house-keeping genes:

adk (adenylate kinase)
ccpA (transcriptional regulator)
recF (recombination protein F)
succC (succinyl-CoA synthetase, subunit beta)
rpoB (DNA-directed RNA polymerase, subunit beta)
spo0A (transcriptional regulator)

PCR amplification:

The primer pairs we use for the PCR amplification of internal fragments of these genes are:
